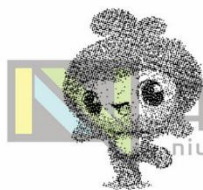

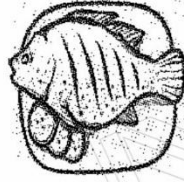

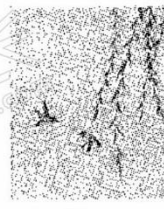

Forest London contributes around ten thousand hours of service every year. From tree planting to community events, our volunteers are always there to lend a helping hand. We expect you to join us. Here are many ways.

VOLUNTEER ROLES

Tree Planter

Volunteer with Forest London to plant trees in parks and natural areas in spring and fall.

Time: Usually two to three hours on the weekends.

Training: No training is required. We teach you how to plant a tree at the start of every planting event, so please arrive on time.



Tree Mascot

We need friendly people to wear our tree mascot costume at community events. The costume is light-weight and easy to wear.

Time: Two to three hours each time, usually on the weekend.

Training: One-hour basic training.



Tree Aftercare Assistant

Care for trees during their first few years to make sure of their health. You may, for example, provide the trees with protection from harmful weeds.

Time: Usually one to one and a half hours on weeknights or Saturday mornings.

Training: No training is required. We will teach you how to care for trees at the start of every aftercare event, so please arrive on time. Any necessary equipment will be provided.



Storyteller

If you are a skilled writer and like to take photos, we have a job for you! Storytellers attend our events to take photos and interview volunteers. Your work will be posted on our website.

Time: Usually two hours at events to collect material and take pictures, and more time to write stories and upload photos. At least two stories per year.

Training: One-hour basic training.

Parents are often surprised at their children's ability to use technology. A five-year-old child may easily find and use apps on a smart phone. A ten-year-old child can move up through the levels of a video game easily. Their parents may think their children were born geniuses!

Natural geniuses, however, are not common. But your parents are right if they think you are smarter than them. Most children are born smarter than their parents. This has been proved on IQ tests around the world recently. These tests have shown that over the last 100 years, each new generation has become smarter than the older one. In other words, you are smarter than your parents and your parents are smarter than your grandparents.

This increase in intelligence is called the "Flynn Effect". It was named after

James Flynn. Flynn is a university professor in New Zealand. He first noticed this in 1980. According to his research, with each new generation, average IQ scores would increase by twenty percent.

But why are people getting smarter? Flynn and many other researchers believe this has something to do with technology. New technologies have further developed our brains. They have made us think better. So we may be better at completing the missing parts of a puzzle than our parents.

However, being smart doesn't make you wise. Wisdom comes with age and experience. A killer score on a computer game will not help you solve the everyday problems of life. For that, a smart kid will turn to the wisdom of his parents and grandparents.

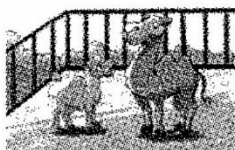
